No claim is made for the best hydrographic source. The Florida Department of Transportation is not responsible for inaccuracies in any data, including, but not limited to, information on other sources.

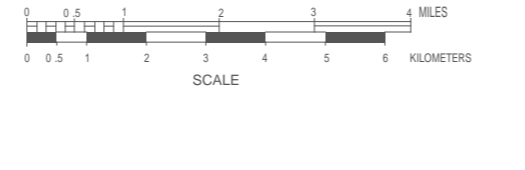
